C.A.F.R.P.



The Children's Alliance Family Resource Project (CAFRP) provides grant money to financially assist families experiencing a financial crisis which is placing children in the home at-risk for entering out of home or entering state's custody.

At-risk children: Children who reside in families that are in crisis; financial, psychological, legal, medical, or any other unforeseen circumstances that present danger to the child's well being. Children served under this portion of the grant are not in SRS custody, not in law enforcement custody and are not receiving SRS contract services.

The goals of the project are:

- assist families in achieving maximum self-sufficiency,
- provide emergency care for children in temporary law enforcement custody or voluntary foster care,
- have children live in a safe, stable and supportive environment where they thrive and families are strengthened.

Clients will be screened on a first-come, first-served basis. All requests for funding will be verified to ensure the integrity of requests. Flex funds will be used creatively to address situational financial issues or to help alleviate stressors bearing upon families that are contributing to the immediate crisis that lead to the referral.

General Guidelines Family Resource Project

Eligibility

- Client must have legal custody of child.
- Clients must demonstrate ability to meet future financial obligations without future assistance.
- Clients must supply support documents pertaining to assistance needed, such as utility bill, or rent eviction notice.
- Clients must provide information and substantiating documents as required for application.
